

NC Home Missions is pleased to announce that we have agreed to partner with Glad Tidings FWB Church of Asheboro, NC in a Church Revitalization project. While it is still the desire of NC Missions to plant new churches in our state, we feel that it is just as important to keep our current churches open. Glad Tidings, a former mission church celebrated their 23rd Homecoming November 5th, 2017 and we want to see them celebrate many more in the future. After much prayer and several meetings with the members of the church, the board and the church have agreed on the following terms and conditions of this project.

- * The joint revitalization project with Glad Tidings will last four years.
- * Our goal is to raise \$4200 per month.
- * Each year the amount of financial contributions from the Missions Board will be reduced by 25%
- * The Board will have annual and semi-annual evaluations of the churches financial records and their outreach efforts.
- * The Church has agreed to accept the recommendations of the Mission Board, for any expenditures other than normal operational expenses, during the entire project.
- * All monies raised for this project will be sent to NC Home Mission and then distributed to Glad Tidings at the end of each month.
- * The Board and the Church have agreed that the partnership can be dissolved at any time for reasons that would warrant such actions.
- * Glad Tidings, as an autonomous church have reached a unanimous decision to call Rev. Dale McCoy as their new pastor. After two interviews and checking of references, the board also accepted the decision with a unanimous vote.



We realized that this being a new venture for NC Missions, we needed guidance and input, and spoke with Jim McComas and Brad Ransom from the Free Will Baptist North American Ministries. Our project and its guidelines were explained to Brother Jim, and his approval was given. We are now asking our NC churches to get behind this project with your prayers and financial contributions. Brother Dale will soon be available to come to your church and or District Association meetings to share this work with you.
